

Information about processing personal data

Quality Missala, ul. Kędzierskiego 3B, 01- 493 Warsaw, processes your personal data obtained in connection with your purchases in Perfumeria Quality boutiques and your use of the www.PerfumeriQuality.pl website.

I. Who is the administrator of my personal data?

1. The administrator of your personal data is Stanisława Missala, running a business under the name Quality Missala, ul. Kędzierskiego 3B, 01-493 Warsaw (hereinafter: "Administrator").

II. What are the purposes of processing personal data?

Personal data obtained during the conclusion of the contract, registration of the account on the site, marketing consent we use for the following purposes:

1. conclusion and performance of the contract - for the duration of the contract and the time after it completion, until the contract is properly performed,
2. performance of legal obligations of the Administrator:
 - a. issuing and storing invoices, including accounting documents,
 - b. maintenance of the right to withdraw the contract and the complaint, in time and form provided by the law,
 - c. for the time necessary to fulfill the legal obligation imposed on the Administrator,
3. sending marketing content - for the duration of the consent to receive marketing content.

III. What is the legal basis of the processing personal data and the period of their storage?

1. The legal basis for the processing of personal data by the Administrator is:
 - a. art. 6 par. 1 lit. a of the Regulation of European Parliament and Council of European Union 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 *on the protection of natural persons in connection with the processing of personal data and in the case the free workflow of such data and the repeal of directive 95/46/WE* (hereinafter: "RODO"), i.e. obtained consent for the processing of personal data,
 - b. art. 6 par. 1. lit. b RODO, i.e. fulfillment of the contract or taking action on requests before concluding the contract,
 - c. art. 6 par. 1 lit. c RODO, i.e. fulfillment of the legal obligation imposed on the Administrator,
2. Personal data will be kept for the duration of the consent, validity of the agreement and legal obligation specified in par. 1.

IV. Whom the personal data can be shared with?

1. We may disclose your data to:
 - a. entities providing to us consultancy services and legal, tax and accounting assistance; entities conducting payment activity,
 - b. entities that provide us with services related to IT support and programming,
 - c. postal operators and courier companies in the range necessary to provide services for us,
2. We do not transfer personal data outside of the European Economic Area.

V. What rights do I have?

1. You may at any time demand from the Administrator an access to personal data being processed, their correction, removal or processing curtailment.
2. You have the right to demand from the Administrator to transfer personal data to another data administrator.
3. You can use all of the above-mentioned rights via:

VI. Do I have the right to object in relation to the processing of my personal data?

1. Regardless of the rights specified in par. V, you are entitled to object to the processing of your personal data at any time.
2. After receiving your objection, we will stop processing your personal data unless otherwise required by law.

VII. Am I allowed to submit a complaint regarding the processing of my personal data?

1. You have the possibility to submit a complaint to the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection if you consider that the processing of your personal data violates the law.

VIII. How are my personal data protected?

1. We inform you that the processing of personal data is carried out in a secure manner, in accordance with the regulation of services provision and the law, including RODO.
2. We make every effort to provide all possible means of physical, technical and organizational protection of personal data against their accidental or intentional destruction, accidental loss, change, unauthorized disclosure, use or access, in accordance with all binding regulations.
